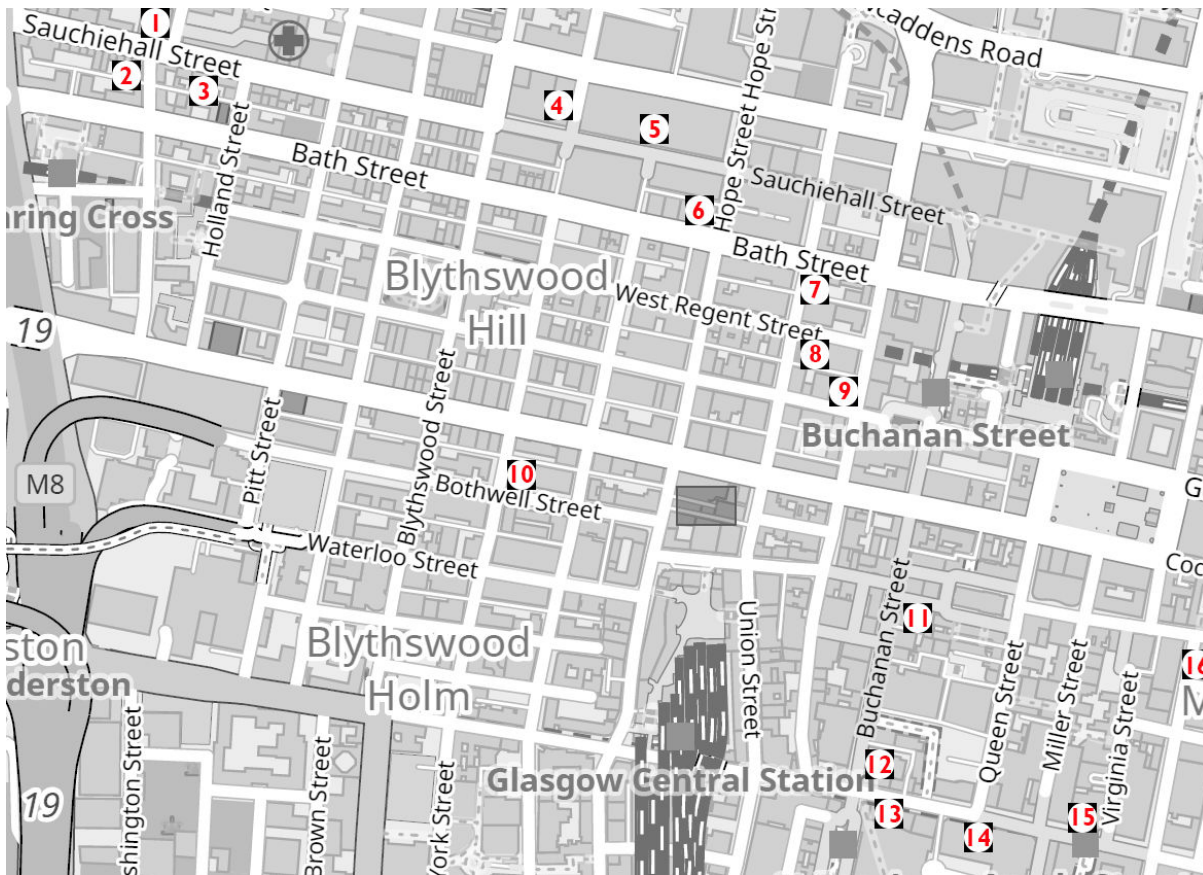


## GLASGOW CITY CENTRE WALKING TOUR
